

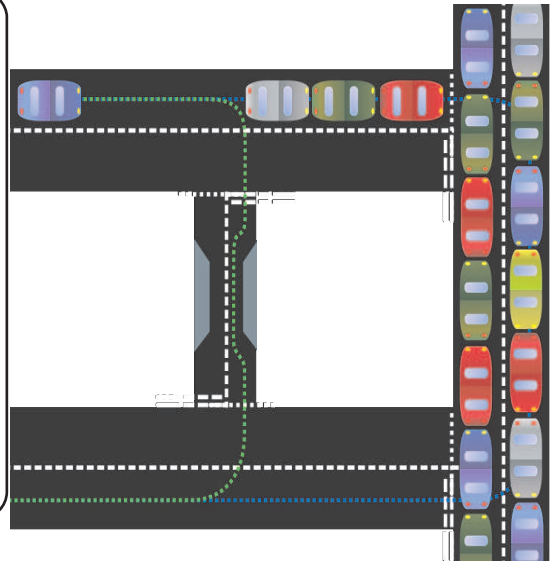

Previous meetings have had presentations from topics including biology, road transport, urban planning and telecommunications networks as well as applied mathematics.
